Dear Bird Records Committee,

I wish to report a sighting of a male Black-and-White Warbler seen in my yard in West Jordan on 11 May 1999.

My initial impression was that it was a small woodpecker, because it was creeping in circles around the trunk of my pine tree, and then my spruce tree. I ruled that out because the stripes were all vertical rather than horizontal. The crown appeared white with a black stripe on either side. There was a white eyebrow, then a black eyestripe which included a connected black patch on the cheek. Breast and sides were streaked with black on white, and black and white stripes extended vertically down the back.

I held off sending this in hopes of seeing him again and getting a photograph. Unfortunately he has not returned, and my migratory visitors have dwindled to very few.
