- C = Common (Found consistently in fair numbers in appropriate habitat and season)
- U = Uncommon (Found consistently in small numbers in appropriate habitat and season)
- R = Rare (Found infrequently but regularly in very small numbers in proper habitat and season)
- O = Occasional (Seldom found in the state and not reported annually)
- I = Irregular (Abundance varies greatly from year to year — may be common one year and absent the next)

Status

- P = Permanent Resident (Found year round in the state)
- S = Summer Resident (Present in the state during the nesting season)
- W = Winter Visitor (Present in the state during January and/or February)
- T = Transient (Migrates through the state in spring and/or fall)

*Species found primarily in Washington County.

This checklist contain 380 species accepted by the Utah Ornithological Society Bird Records Committee through 1990, arranged in taxonomic order and using nomenclature of the 6th American Ornithologists' Union Check-list of North American Birds (1983) and the 35th (1985), 36th (1987), and 37th (1989) Supplements to the A.O.U.
