**Here are the Area Locations to put with the Area numbers above:**

- 1- Southeast Bountiful, including Mueller Park and Bountiful Golf Course.
- 2- City Creek Canyon, including Memory Grove.
- 3- Avenues area including City Cemetery and Lindsay Gardens.
- 4- University of Utah, foothills and canyon mouths.
- 5- Red Butte Canyon and Forest Service land.
- 6- East Bench, including Pioneer State Park and the Zoo.
- 7- Emigration Canyon
- 8- Parley's Gulch and several golf courses
- 9- Upper Millcreek, a mile or so up the canyon and along the foothills.
- 10- Southeast Circle – southwest Holladay including Cottonwood Creekside and Murray parks.
- 11- Southwest Circle –several miles of Jordan River and Meadowbrook Golf Course
- 12- West Circle, includes easternmost of Lee Kay ponds.
- 13- Airport with golf course and numerous wetlands west and north.
- 14- Lower Jordan River, close to mouth of river and many nearby ponds and sinks.
- 15- Northwest Circle – more wetlands in the Jordan River Delta.
- 16- Capitol Hill, Ensign Peak and Beck Street gravel pits.
- 17- City Center – mainly Liberty Park
